


Exploring Afro-Brazilian Culture in Salvador, Bahia

Professional Journey and Learning Experience to Brazil

April 13-23, 2023



CONTEXT

This is a 10-day program to Salvador da Bahia – Brazil’s ‘Black Rome’. Here we explore Brazil’s African heritage. From the city’s Pelourinho core a UNESCO World Heritage site you will explore Afro-Brazilians’ rich and diverse culture and history.

AFRO-BRAZILIANS Their History and Culture

From April 13-23, 2023 in Salvador, we will explore a history and culture with links to Congo Angola Nigeria and elsewhere. Here descendants of Africans brought to Brazil during the Atlantic slave trade created a legacy of tenacity and resilience.

Like their US and Caribbean counterparts Brazilians continue to grapple with slavery’s profound ramifications. Via roundtable dialogues school observations and cultural activities we explore heritage and history – but also draw Brazilian comparisons to the US civil rights and Black Lives Matter movements. Alongside Brazilian subject matter experts and colleague-educators we ask whether access to high-quality education is equal or whether it is the province only of those with means.

We assess gender equality and whether Brazil’s commitment to achieving it is robust. We’ll come to understand how Brazilians view race relative to social class.
