2nd Payment: July 20, 2022 | Amount Due: \$1100

3rd Payment: August 20, 2022 | Amount Due: \$1000

4th Payment: September 10, 2022 | Amount Due: \$1000; early birds pay \$700

Cancellation within the 90-day period immediately prior to departure for Cairo will result in the full or partial forfeiture of paid funds, according to the following schedule:

90 - 65 days	50% of total payment
64 - 45 days	60% of total payment
44 - 30 days	80% of total payment
29 - 0 days	100% of total payment

Cancellations must be made in writing and will be effective on the date that Alterra receives the cancellation notice in our in our offices.

Note: A canceling participant may avoid the aforementioned penalties by securing a replacement participant.
