civil rights and Black Lives Matter
movements. Alongside Brazilian subject
matter experts and colleague-educators we
ask whether access to high-quality education
is equal or whether it is the province only of
those with means.

We assess gender equality and whether Brazil's commitment to achieving it is robust. We'll come to understand how Brazilians view race relative to social class.
